
Innovation Auditing

- 1. PURPOSE/PROBLEM PHASE: Do you have (or see) enough prompts? Do you intentionally search for or generate ideas for those prompts?
- 2. SELECTION PHASE: Do you have an idea pipeline a way for challenges, opportunities, and ideas to be discussed, developed, and tested?
- 3. REALIZATION PHASE: Do you deploy your ideas into the real world? Do you have ways of systematically giving them permission, time, and resources to flourish?
- 4. POST-INNOVATION PHASE: Do you capture what you learn from your innovation process? Do you anticipate or track the systemic impacts of your innovation?

Then, given the problem phases you identify above: what steps or transitions throughout the process give you trouble? Use the Innovation Education model to identify the skills and learning objectives you can develop to help overcome these issues.
